Established customized portals for our user community and developed a variety of templates which inform, promote, or share content.

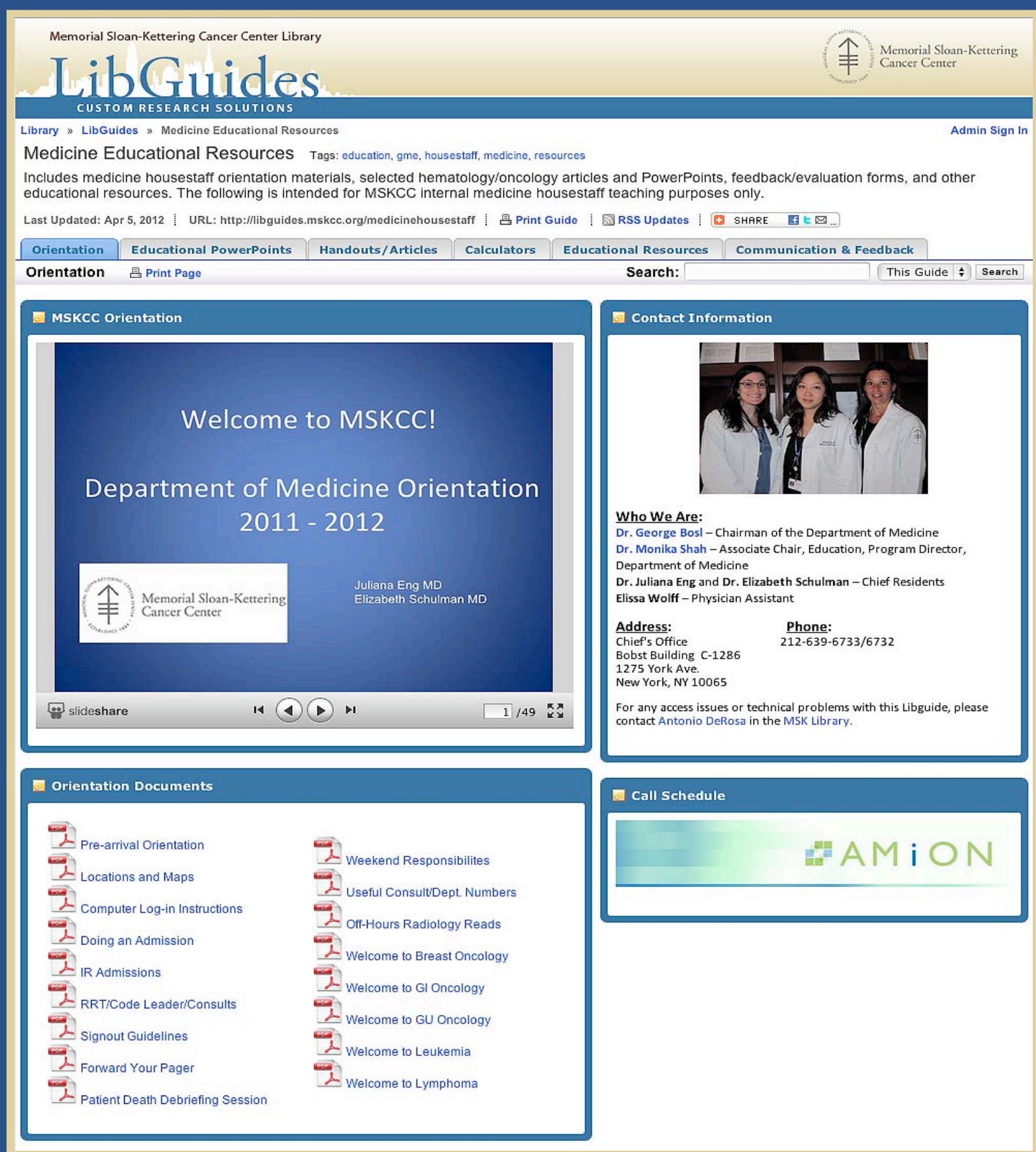

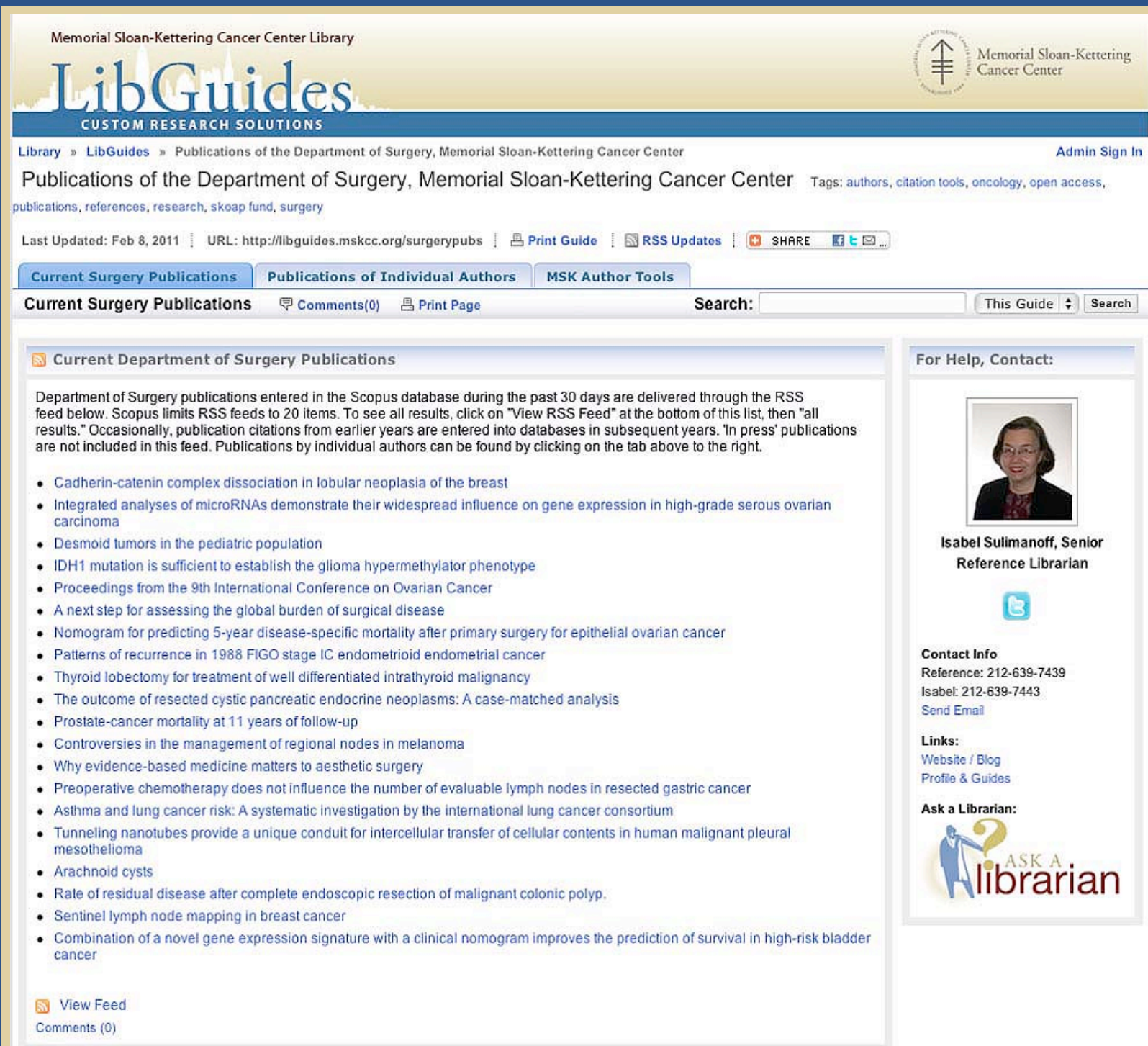
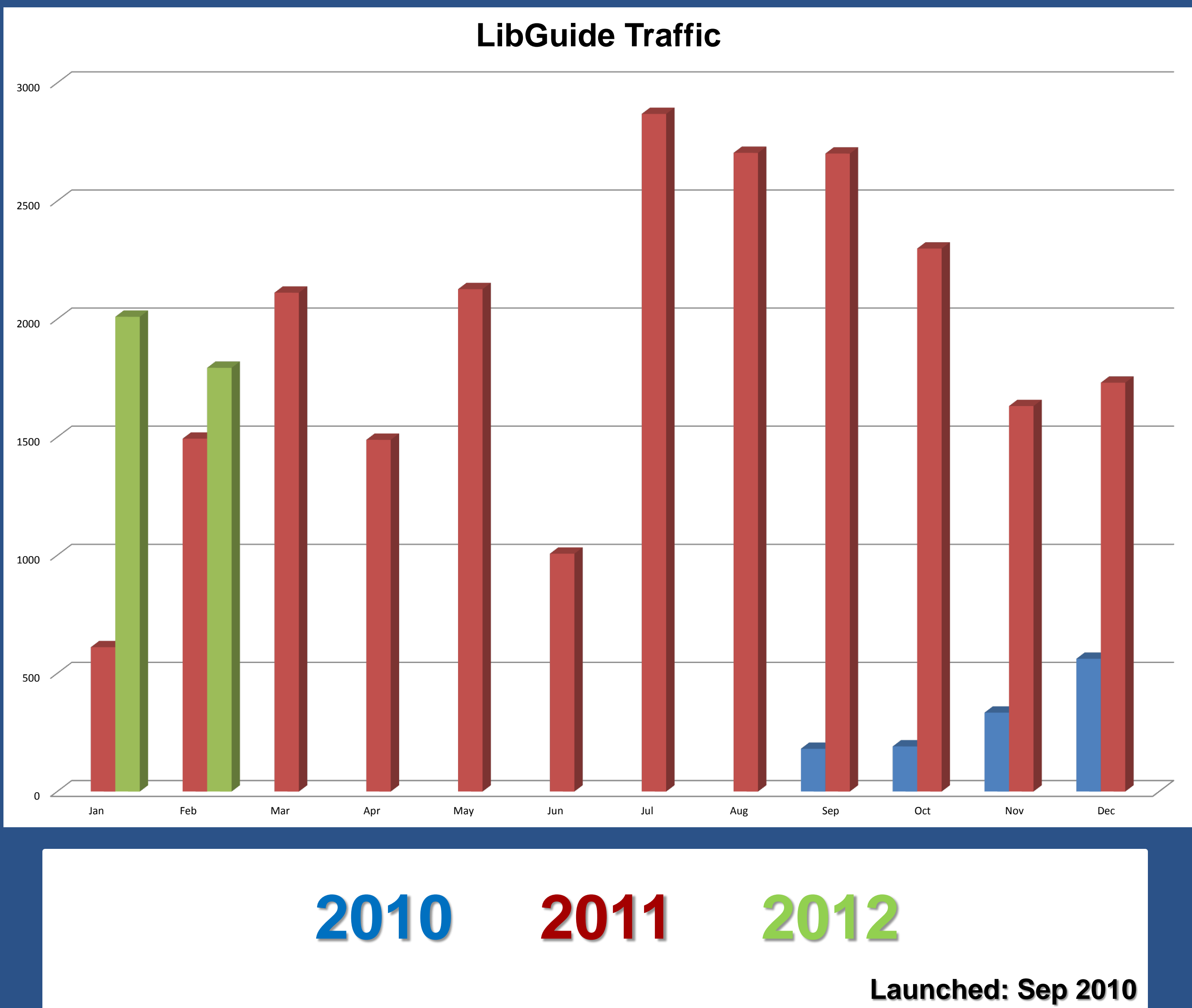
CONCLUSION
